Cherry Springs State Park

The park is one of the darkest sites in the state and has been designated as Pennsylvania's first Dark Sky Park. Visit the Night Sky Viewing area located north of Rt. 44 (opposite the gated Astronomy Observation Field).

Pennsylvania Grand Canyon

At its deepest point, Pine Creek Gorge is 1,450 feet deep and nearly one mile wide. Great for hiking or just sightseeing.
